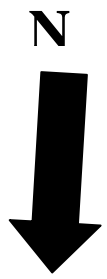
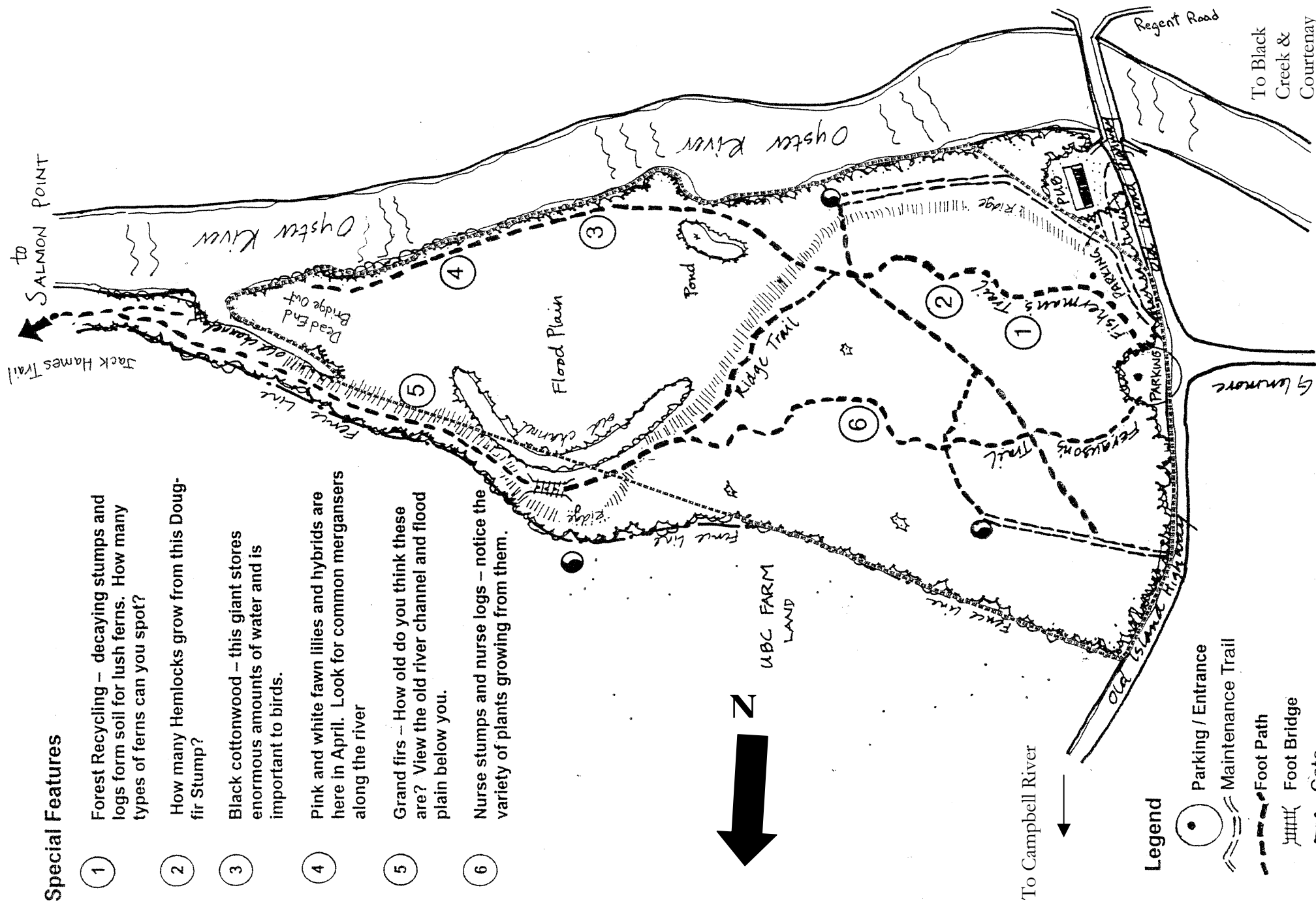


# OYSTER RIVER NATURE PARK

## Special Features

- ① Forest Recycling – decaying stumps and logs form soil for lush ferns. How many types of ferns can you spot?
- ② How many Hemlocks grow from this Douglas fir Stump?
- ③ Black cottonwood – this giant stores enormous amounts of water and is important to birds.
- ④ Pink and white fawn lilies and hybrids are here in April. Look for common mergansers along the river
- ⑤ Grand firs – How old do you think these are? View the old river channel and flood plain below you.
- ⑥ Nurse stumps and nurse logs – notice the variety of plants growing from them.
