The Skate Patrol/Instructor I is responsible for providing safe skating sessions to the public by keeping patrons informed on the rules/policies that ensure a fun & safe skating experience. Other responsibilities include distributing and sharpening skates, assisting patrons with equipment or skating difficulties, answering questions, administering first aid, teaching skating, hockey and private lessons, checking for receipt of payment, assisting with special events, maintaining records, completing general housekeeping around public skating areas and skate-shop.

- Completion of Grade 10
- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Previous hockey or figure skating experience
- Previous experience working with children in a leadership capacity
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR "C" Certificate
