

## **BYLAW NO. 138**

# A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2183, BEING STRATHCONA HERITAGE CONSERVATION EXTENDED SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW 2000

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 2183, established a service to provide heritage conservation within its electoral areas;

AND WHEREAS the Comox-Strathcona Regional District was divided into the Comox Valley Regional District and the Strathcona Regional District by letters patent effective February 15, 2008;

**AND WHEREAS** a bylaw of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as a bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

**AND WHEREAS** the aforesaid Bylaw No. 2183 currently applies to all electoral areas of the Strathcona Regional District except Electoral Area A (Kyuquot/Nootka-Sayward);

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to amend the provisions of Bylaw No. 2183;

**AND WHEREAS** the consent of at least 2/3 of the participants of the service has been obtained in accordance with s.802 of the *Local Government Act*;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

#### **Amendments**

1. Bylaw No. 2183 is amended by deleting sections 3 and 4 in their entirety and substituting therefore the following new sections 3 and 4;

#### Participating Areas

3. The participating areas for the service are Electoral Area B (Cortes Island) and Electoral Area C (Discovery Islands-Mainland Inlets).

#### Service Area Boundaries

4. The boundaries of the service area are coterminus with Electoral Area B (Cortes Island) and Electoral Area C (Discovery Islands-Mainland Inlets).

### Citation

2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 138, being Strathcona Heritage Conservation Extended Service Establishment Bylaw 2000, Amendment No. 2.
