



BYLAW NO. 326

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE HOLDING OF A REFERENDUM TO OBTAIN THE OPINION OF THE ELECTORS FOR ELECTORAL AREA B (CORTES ISLAND) REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNITY HALL SERVICE

WHEREAS the Regional District may, by bylaw, provide for the holding of a referendum to obtain the opinion of the electors on a question regarding a service that is or may be operated by the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District wishes to obtain the opinion of the electors regarding the proposal to establish a community hall service within and for the benefit of Electoral Area B (Cortes Island);

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Referendum Authorized

1. The Regional District is hereby authorized to seek the opinion of the electors for Electoral Area B (Cortes Island) on the question of whether or not the Regional District should consider establishing a community hall service for the said Electoral Area B.

Question to be Decided

2. The question to be submitted for a decision by the electors is:

"Are you in favour of the Strathcona Regional District preparing a bylaw to establish a service for funding community halls on Cortes Island on the condition that the bylaw would require the approval of the electors before it is adopted?"




