



BYLAW NO. 80

A BYLAW TO REPEAL YORK ROAD FIRE PROTECTION LOCAL SERVICE AREA CONVERSION AND ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW NO. 1495, 1992

WHEREAS the former Comox Strathcona Regional District has, by Bylaw No. 1495, established a service to provide fire protection to the York Road area of Electoral Area D;

AND WHEREAS an establishing bylaw of the former Comox Strathcona Regional District that authorizes the operation of a service within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as an establishing bylaw of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the service established by Bylaw No. 1495 applies to portions of the Strathcona Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Regional District wishes to repeal the aforesaid Bylaw No. 1495;

AND WHEREAS the consent of at least 2/3 of the participants of the service has been obtained pursuant to Section 802 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Repeal

1. Bylaw No. 1495, being York Road Fire Protection Local Service Conversion and Establishment Bylaw, 1992 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Effective Date

2. This bylaw shall take effect on December 31, 2010.

Citation

3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 80, being York Road Fire Protection Service Conversion and Establishment Bylaw 1992, Repeal Bylaw 2010.

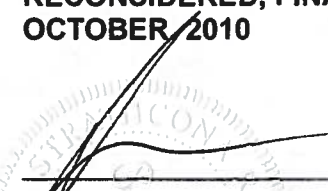

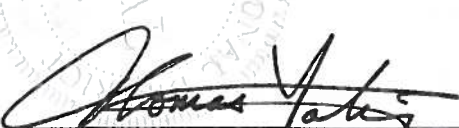
