



BYLAW NO. 618

A BYLAW TO CONVERT THE AUTHORITY FOR PROVIDING A FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE WITHIN ELECTORAL AREA D

WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District was provided the authority, by supplementary letters patent dated December 22, 1977, to provide fire protection services to Electoral Areas E and F and a defined portion of Electoral Area D as a specified area of that Regional District;

AND WHEREAS Electoral Areas E and F are now part of the City of Campbell River;

AND WHEREAS the said fire protection service was provided as a continued service of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District in accordance with the previous continuation authority as defined in the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District was, by Order in Council 059/08, divided into the Comox Valley Regional District and the Strathcona Regional District on February 15, 2008;

AND WHEREAS a service of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District that was operated within all or part of the area comprising the Strathcona Regional District remains in force as a service of the Strathcona Regional District until amended or repealed;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board wishes to convert the fire protection service to a service to be exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw in accordance with s.341 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the written consent of the participating areas for the service has been obtained pursuant to the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Strathcona Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Service Converted

1. The fire protection service established by Division XXX of supplementary letters patent of the former Comox-Strathcona Regional District is hereby converted to a service of the Strathcona Regional District to be exercised under the authority of this bylaw in accordance with the provisions of the *Local Government Act*.

Name of Service

2. The service converted by this bylaw shall be known as the Electoral Area D fire protection service.

Participating Area

3. The participating area for the service is Electoral Area D (Oyster Bay-Buttle Lake).

Service Area Boundaries

4. The boundaries for the service area include that part of Electoral Area D shown outlined in bold on Appendices 'A' and 'B', attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Service Defined

5. The Regional District may provide fire protection services within the area established by this bylaw including measures to protect persons and property from the threat of fire in accordance with the *Local Government Act*.

Cost Recovery

6. The annual net cost of the service shall be recovered by a property value tax levied against the net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.

Requisition Limit

7. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the service is the greater of \$750,000 or the equivalent of a property value tax rate of \$0.82 per \$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.

Citation

8. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Bylaw No. 618, being Electoral Area D Fire Protection Service Conversion Bylaw 2025.

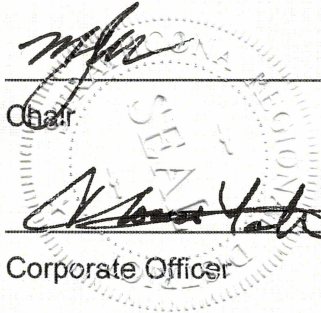

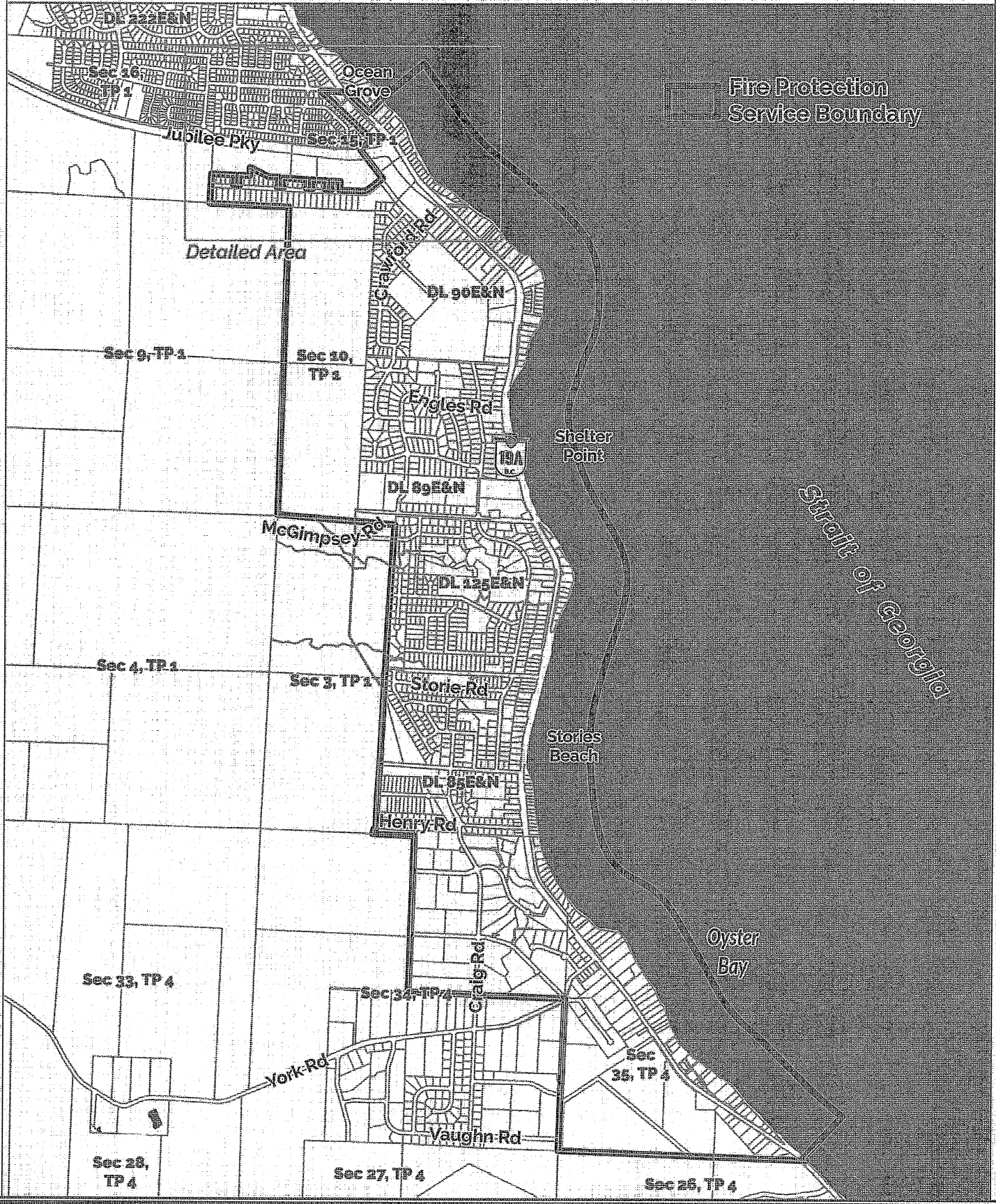
