JOB SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Program Assistant, Aquatics and the Aquatic Coordinator the Lifeguard Instructor's primary function is accident prevention and teaching swimming lessons, specialty programs and fitness classes.

JOB DUTIES

- Teach swimming skills to a variety of different levels and ages and abilities
- Assist with keeping the pool areas clean
- Assist with water chemistry tests
- Lead, direct, or influence patron behavior
- Prepare reports: lesson cards, first aid and incident reports
- Promote a friendly and enjoyable recreational atmosphere
- Educate patrons on how to use the facility safely
- Additional aquatic facility duties as assigned
- Conducts safety checks on equipment before use
- Administers first aid to patrons and staff and ensures all incidents are documented
- Attend training to maintain standards of required licenses and certificates
