ORGANIZATIONAL PROFILE

The Strathcona Regional District is the government body providing services to over 44,000 residents within north central Vancouver Island, Discovery Islands, and mainland area inlets, representing four electoral areas, a treaty First Nation and five member municipalities. Services include, water & sewage systems, fire protection, land use planning, parks, bylaw enforcement, recreation, broadband, and emergency planning and response.

The Strathcona Regional District is governed by a 14-member Board of elected officials. The administrative boundaries lie within many traditional First Nations territories and the SRD works closely with 10 local First Nations communities.

Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex is a multi-use facility located within the City of Campbell River and is owned and operated by the Strathcona Regional District. The complex includes two ice arenas, a leisure ice pad, a 37.5 metre pool, a leisure pool, a weight room, a fitness studio and meeting rooms. This is a well used facility that services and is funded by the taxpayers of the City of Campbell River and Electoral Area "D" – Black Creek – Oyster Bay.

ABOUT THE ROLE

As a member of the senior management team, the Senior Manager, Strathcona Gardens is responsible for the overall management of recreation and leisure services at the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex. The Senior Manager prepares reports and recommendations through the Chief Administrative Officer to the Strathcona Gardens Commission and the Strathcona Regional District Board of Directors on policies, bylaws, and all other matters related to the operation of the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex. The position supports the Commission and Board in the development of both its short term and long term planning and provides direct leadership to a team of three exempt managers and the administrative services for the Strathcona Gardens Recreation Complex.

This is an exciting recreational leadership opportunity, in the public sector environment. The preferred candidate will have a university degree in Recreation Administration/Management, Public Administration, or a related field supplemented by a minimum of seven years of progressive management and operational experience in recreation services. The ideal candidate will have additional training or education in business administration, financial management, project management, local government administration, communications, and emergency management. The position requires an inclusive and strategic leader with skills and experience in recreation program and policy development, facility operations, and service delivery with demonstrated interpersonal communication and community engagement skills.
